## *2006 Juvenile and Forensic Science Seminar*

The Georgia Public Defender Standards Council, The Center for Modern Forensic Practice, Emory's Indigent Defense Clinic and The Georgia Innocence Project invite you to attend the 2006 joint Juvenile and Forensic Science Seminar. The seminar will be held at the Emory Center for Lifelong Learning, located at Emory's Briarcliff Campus, 1256 Briarcliff Road in Atlanta.

### Schedule

The Juvenile Defender Seminar will be held on Tuesday, November 7 and Wednesday, November 8<sup>th</sup>. The Forensic Science Seminar will be held on Wednesday, November 8<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup>.

The seminar will be held from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. everyday. A continental breakfast will be provided.

### Lodging

Lodging accommodations are available for Monday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, November 7<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, November 8<sup>th</sup> at the Holiday Inn Decatur, located at 130 Clairmont Avenue, Decatur, GA 30030. Please provide the name, position, and gender (for anyone who will need hotel accommodations) for each registrant on the attached registration form.

#### **PLEASE TAKE NOTE:**

All participants, except CPDs and Level IV attorneys, will share rooms. If a participant wishes to pick up the cost of his/her private room, the cost per night is \$124 and payment in the form of a check should be mailed to GPDSC along with the registration form. **If payment for the room is not received prior to October 23<sup>rd</sup>, the single room will be cancelled and the participant will be placed with a roommate. ### State, County-Contracted, & County Funded Issues:

GPDSC will cover the costs for state employees only. This also includes counties which have contracted with the state (GPDSC). Counties that have not contracted with GPDSC will have to cover the costs for any county-funded positions, including lodging, travel and meals. If you are a county-funded employee, you will be charged the following to attend the workshop:

Hotel: \$124 for a single room per night; \$62 for a shared room per night.

Registration Fee: There will be a \$125 registration fee for all county funded employees. This does not include a hotel room. Note\* We will NOT register any county-funded person without receiving the registration fee with the registration form. All money must be paid up front.
